### 2019 Olema Rosé Côtes de Provence (19.2)

**Taster's notes:** "Zippy strawberries, peaches and kiwi flavors. Very fruit forward with a bouncy saline finish."

**Winery/vineyards/winemaking:** Olema, the sister winery to Amici, may be in Sonoma, but winemaker Tony Biagi headed to Provence, specifically the village of Vidauban, when former Houstonian John Harris' team decided to add a rosé to the portfolio. The blend is grenache (40 percent), cinsault (40) and syrah (15) with a little carignan and mourvèdre added, too. The grapes were pressed straight away with minimal skin contact, then went through a cold fermentation. Alcohol: 13 percent.
